- Most of the shops and restaurants are in the streets left and right of the train station.
- There is a postbox by the small bus stop next to OM.
- The post in the Press Shop is a mini post office.



## Public Transport Information for Guests

\*Download the SNCB/NMBS App for easy navigation and route planning.

### Bus:

- *De Lijn* is the local bus company. One way tickets can be bought on the bus.
- There are multiple trip tickets available at the Press Shop in Zaventem with good savings compared to one-way tickets. More than one person can share a multiple trip ticket.
- The 272 bus leaves from the bus stop about 100 meters from OM's front door and goes to Brussels North Train Station (Brussel Noord). To come back take bus 272 to Zaventem Airport (or Keerbergen) and ask the driver to tell you when **HOEKPLEIN** stop is coming (one after Zaventem Train Station).
- In Brussels itself you may need another ticket, as De Lijn is only taking you there and back.

### Train:

- Ticket machines are at the train station.
- If you are going on more than one trip it is cheaper to buy a multiple trip ticket (Key Card with 10 trips).
- When coming from Brussels take the **S2 train towards Leuven**, but make sure it stops at **Zaventem Train Station (Zaventem Dorp)** and not only at the airport. *(The Airport stop costs extra)*
- When using the yellow timetables make sure you're looking at the right day as there are two different ones, one for Monday to Friday and one for the weekends and holidays.

### **Walking To & From Zaventem Train Station:**

Tip: The "SNCB/NMBS" train APP is helpful for planning a trip & getting accurate times.

- ⇒ **From OM to Train Station:** Exit OM parking lot to the right, follow road, right hand turn through the tunnel, then left immediately onto Keibergstraat and stay on that street, following the railway until you arrive.
- ⇒ **From Train Station to OM:** Exit to Keibergstraat side (although both sides can work), walk away from downtown parallel the train tracks, turn right at and through the tunnel on Fabrieksstraat, continue left once you come through the tunnel to continue on Fabrieksstraat . Follow same road until you arrive at OM.
